A Little Known Fact: In March 1955, 15 yr old Claudette Colvin, was one of the first women in Montgomery, Al who refused to sit at the back of the bus, occurring nine months before Rosa Parks' stand that launched the Montgomery bus boycott. Arrested and thrown in jail, she was 1 of 4 women who challenged the bus segregation law in court.</p>
